● Everyone is included

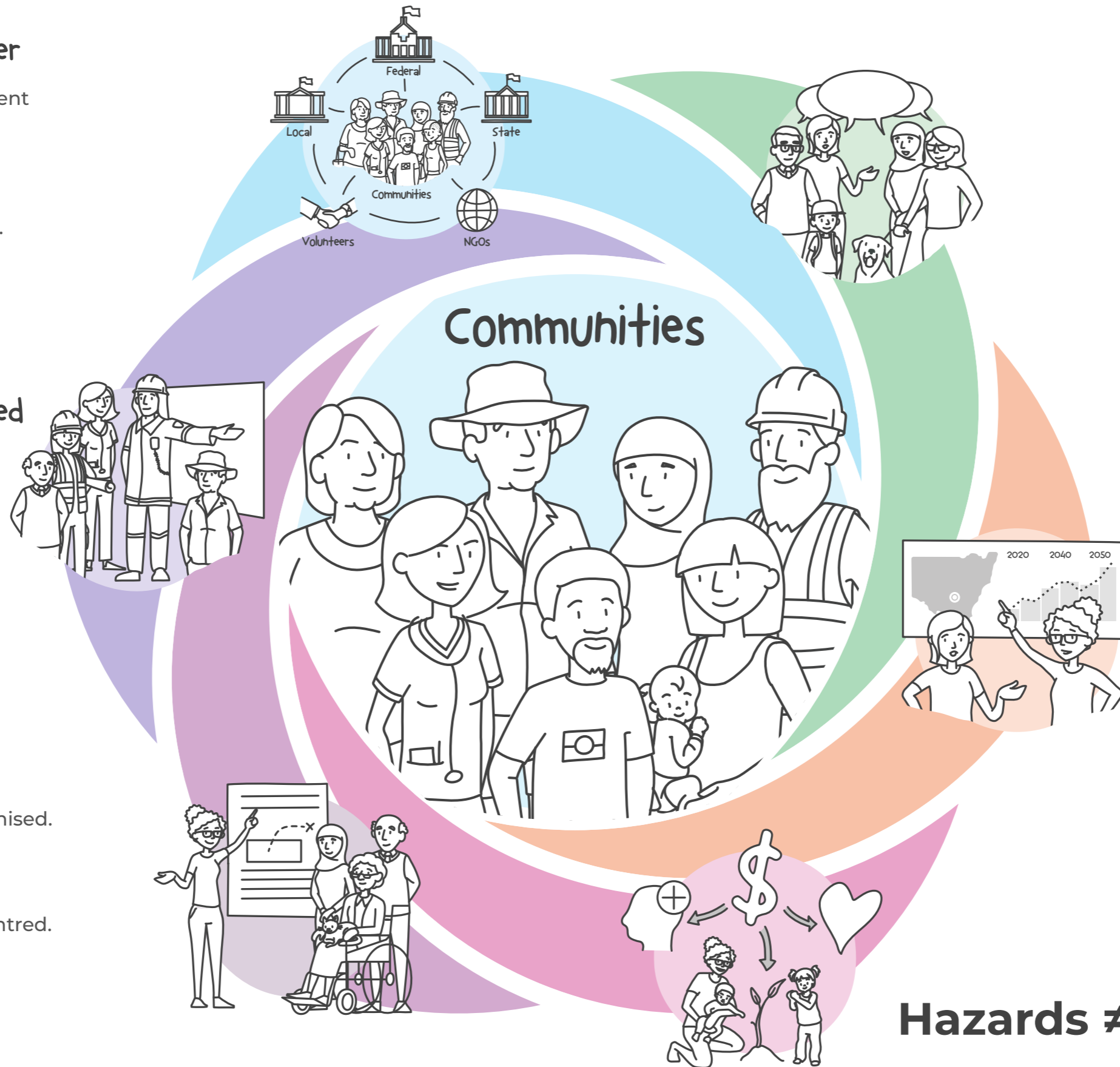
- Diverse needs are included.
