

Purpose and meaning


We're big enough to have a whole-ofgovernment impact, but small enough to bring our staff together regularly to collaborate and grow.

International engagement


Get exposure to digital leaders and delegations overseas. We share insights and learnings with international neighbours to increase our respective digital capabilities.

Balance and flexibility

Access flexible working arrangements to balance how, when and where you work — including remote.



Flexible work

We offer remote and flexible working arrangements. You can pick a schedule to balance your personal and work responsibilities. We have modern offices close to public transport in the heart of Canberra and Sydney.

Supporting your health

Access a free and confidential Employee Assistance Program (EAP) anywhere and any time in Australia. We also provide free yearly flu vaccinations and hold regular health events to keep you healthy.

Family support

We offer 18 days of paid personal/carer's leave per annum, and up to 18 weeks paid parental leave for both primary and secondary carers. Paid leave and support is also available for those experiencing domestic and family violence.

Flexible remuneration

Make the most of flexible remuneration. You can salary sacrifice car leases, electronic devices, superannuation, airline memberships and more.

Inclusion and belonging


Join a team that values all experiences, skills and perspectives. Our biggest strength is our people. We don't just celebrate diversity, it is essential to our success.

Growth and opportunity


Take advantage of professional opportunities and training. Learn new skills and meet your career goals with a wide range of programs, courses and resources.

Work with purpose

- Make an impact through purposeful work that leverages your unique talents.
- Get a whole-of-government view on ICT strategies and investments and emerging digital issues.
- Use your skills and influence to inspire and enable government to put people and businesses at the centre of digital transformation.
- Make real change and influence digital transformation in neighbouring countries.

Great people

- Work with a team that embraces diversity of thought and fosters meaningful professional relationships.
- Join a small small agency with a big impact where your title isn't as important as your expertise everyone at every level contributes.
- Embark on a journey of continuous learning and advancement with opportunities at all levels.

Health, wellbeing, and life balance

- Join an accredited breastfeeding friendly workplace with paid nursing breaks for parents.
- Access free confidential counselling services anywhere in Australia 24/7.
- Get financial support for remote workers to set up ergonomic home workstations.
- Access dedicated wellbeing rooms for reflection, prayer and meditation.

Professional development

- Get up to \$5,000 per year for study assistance and up to 6 hours per week in study leave.
- Access a comprehensive graduate development program.
- Get up to \$1,500 per year for short courses, conferences and events.
- Get higher duties allowance when you perform higher duties for 10 or more days.

Remuneration

- Access competitive salary arrangements.
- Get performance-based salary advancements.
- Access broadbanding to move between APS1 to APS3 or APS4 to APS6 based on performance and work availability.
- Access flexible remuneration packaging and salary packaging.
- Get 15.4% employer superannuation contributions, based on the fortnightly contribution salary method.

Hours of work

- Work a standard week of 37 hours and 30 minutes with a 7am to 7pm daily bandwidth.
- Access to flextime for APS1 to APS6 level staff and overtime payable with penalty rates ranging from 125% to 200%.
- Access time off in lieu (TOIL) for executive level staff.
- Access flexible working arrangements including part time, job sharing and working from home.

Leave

- Get 20 days annual leave, plus the option to purchase more or cash out excess annual leave.
- Enjoy additional paid closedown between Christmas and New Year's Day.
- Access 18 days personal/carer's leave each year.
- Access up to 18 weeks paid parental leave for both primary and secondary carers, this includes adoption and permanent foster care.
- Get leave for community and emergency work, blood donation and cultural purposes.
- Get broad miscellaneous leave for workplace flexibility.
