Dear Greg,

I am writing to you in your capacity as the Senior Responsible Officer for the Future Aged Care ICT Platform (previously known as Improving Aged Care Data and Tracking Quality (IACDTQ) program) at the Department of Health and Aged Care (the Department).

Under the Cabinet-mandated [Assurance Framework for Digital and ICT investments](#) the DTA works with agencies in planning and implementing fit for purpose assurance arrangements. This includes applying the escalation protocols to support agencies in initiating course corrections swiftly and effectively when projects are at risk of not delivering intended benefits.

The Future Aged Care ICT Platform program has reported its recent delivery confidence assessment as Low which, under the escalation protocols, requires the preparation of a remediation plan which will be assessed and monitored by the DTA and included in reporting to the Minister for Finance.

Action Required

I am seeking your assistance to document the Department’s plan to restore delivery confidence in the Future Aged Care ICT Platform program through a Remediation Plan. If there is an existing Return to Green or remediation plan, we are happy to consider this in the first instance. If a plan does not already exist, we have attached a remediation plan template for you to use. We would be glad to work with you to develop the plan if you require any support with this. Upon receipt, the DTA will review the document and work closely with you on next steps.

The Minister for Finance will be provided with quarterly updates on progress on the remediation plan as part of the DTA’s periodic reporting. Included in this report is your update on the remediation plan and progress against it using the attached Ministerial Reporting template. This template is designed to be a high-level overview of remediation activities and is less detailed than the remediation plan itself.

We are requesting that both the remediation plan and the Ministerial reporting template be provided to portfolio.assurance@dta.gov.au by **5 February 2024**.

I’ve attached the Escalation Protocol factsheet that may answer any initial questions you have, and I would like to arrange a time to meet to discuss further. I’ve copied my assistant, **Section 22**, who can assist in finding a suitable time in our calendars.
